Virginia Carolyn Haggard, 89, of Noxapater, Mississippi, passed away on Monday, May 24, 2021, at Winston Medical Center in Louisville, Mississippi, after complications due to a brief illness. Funeral services will be 4 p.m. Thursday, May 27 at Noxapater Baptist Church with Rev. Chris Vowell officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 2:30 p.m. until service time at the church. Interment will immediately follow the service at Mt. Carmel Cemetery in Noxapater.

Carolyn was born October 27, 1931, to Irvin and Nannie Lou Ellis McBrayer in Winston County, Mississippi. She graduated from Noxapater High School and went on to earn a degree at East Central Junior College in Decatur, Mississippi. Following college, she worked as a secretary at U. S.
