Carolyn Hatcher, 91, passed away on Saturday, August 10, 2024, at BeeHive Homes in Louisville, Mississippi, with her loving family by her side. 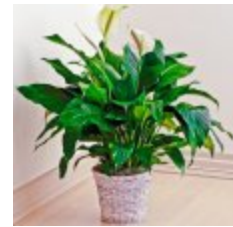

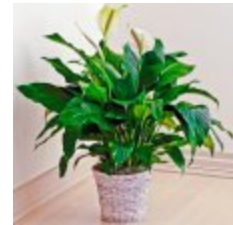
