February 15, 1930 - January 28, 2016

Clayton Sinclair, 85, passed away surrounded by his loving family on Thursday, January 28, 2016, at his residence in Louisville, Mississippi. Visitation will be Friday, January 29, 2016, from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. at Nowell Massey Funeral Home.
