Clifford "Tebo" Daniels went to his eternal rest Saturday, September 27, 2014, after a lengthy illness. Visitation will be on Sunday, September 28, 2014, at Nowell-Massey Funeral Home from 5 p.m. until 8 p.m. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. on Monday, September 29, 2014, at Harmony Baptist Church with Rev. He was born on December 8, 1929, in Neshoba County to Elvin and Bessie Luke Daniels.

Corporation for many years of his career. He also had a private electrical business, farmed, and raised cattle. Mr. "Tebo", as he was lovingly called, enjoyed watching sports on television and traveling to see his daughters, granddaughters, and great-granddaughters play sports. In his high school days, he was known for his ability to play basketball and later for playing and teaching others the fundamentals of the game. In later life, he traveled many miles to play checkers, winning many tournaments and was well-known among his checker peers.
