Connie Frey Wilson, age 74, passed away on Monday, December 27, 2021, at Winston Medical Center in Louisville, Mississippi, with her loving family by her side. Funeral services will be 1 p.m. Thursday, December 30 at South Louisville Baptist Church in Louisville with Bro. Trent Jaudon officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 11 a.m. until service time at the church. Interment will immediately follow the service in Memorial Cemetery.

Connie was born in St. Marys, Ohio, on September 3, 1947, to Lee and Edith Campbell Frey. Currently, she was a member of South Louisville Baptist Church where she enjoyed participating in the Judgment House production. Connie gave her life to the Lord in 1976 and spent many years teaching Sunday school and Vacation Bible School to all ages ranging from very young to senior adults in Gulfport, Mississippi, Norfolk, Virginia, Millington, Tennessee, and Louisville.
