Mr. H. Coy McAdory, 85, passed away on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, at St. Dominic Hospital in Jackson, Mississippi from congestive heart failure. Visitation will be on Friday, May 19, 2017, from 5 p.m. until 8 p.m. at Nowell Massey Funeral Home in Louisville, Mississippi. There will be a second visitation on Saturday, May 20, 2017 at Oak Grove Baptist Church in Noxapater, MS from 10 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., thereafter the funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. with Rev. 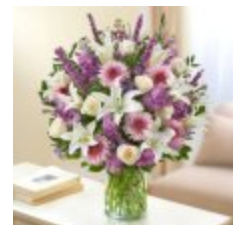
