Daniel Edward Balius, 87, of Louisville passed away on December 5, 2014.

Daniel was born in Biloxi, Mississippi, on February 16, 1927, to the late Opal Guy and Ernst Balius. He was graduated from Biloxi High School on April 1947 and married Marion Vonceil Wells on December 16, 1950.

Daniel served in the military 20 years and volunteered for a 15 month hitch in-country during the Vietnam Conflict. He retired a Master Sargent from the Air Force after which he worked in the United States Postal Service for 23 years.
