



## Mr. Danny White

May 22, 1947 - April 12, 2013

Danny White, age 65, of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, died April 12, 2013, at DCH Hospital after a brief illness. Visitation will be from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. on Sunday, April 14, and on Monday from 12:30 until the time of the service. Services will be held on Monday, April 15, at 2 p.m., in the Nowell-Massey Funeral Home Chapel in Louisville, MS, with Dr. Gil McKee, pastor of First Baptist Church, Tuscaloosa, and the Rev. Jimmy Sartain of Nashville, TN officiating. Interment will follow in Ellison Ridge Baptist Church Cemetery. Danny was a graduate of Nanih Waiya High School and Delta State University. He served as Minister of Music in several Mississippi Baptist Churches for 16 years. The remainder of his career was spent in insurance sales.
