David Lee Reynolds, 66, passed away surrounded by his loving family on Friday, March 12, 2021, at his home in Louisville, Mississippi. Funeral services will be 3 p.m. Sunday, March 14 in the Nowell-Massey Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Keith Williams officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 2 p.m. until service time at Nowell-Massey Funeral Home in Louisville. Interment will immediately follow the service in Flower Ridge Cemetery.

David was born February 1, 1955, to Grady and Odessa Judge Reynolds in Fort Benning, Georgia. He was a 1973 graduate of Noxapater High School and a member of Flower Ridge Methodist Church.
