Dixie Sanders Wylie, 92, went home to be with Jesus on Friday, November 29, 2013. Funeral services are 11 a.m. on Tuesday, December 3, 2013, at Evergreen Baptist Church in Louisville, Mississippi, with Dr. Jeff Holland officiating.
