

## Grady Suttle

November 6, 1936 - July 22, 2024

Grady Earl Suttle, 87, passed away with his loving family at his side on Monday, July 22, 2024, at Winston Medical Center Nursing Home in Louisville, Mississippi. 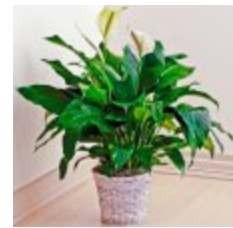
