Gregory A. Brown passed away on Sunday, December 28, 2025, at the age of 63, at his home in Louisville, Mississippi, with his loving family by his side. Funeral services will be 1 p.m. Wednesday, December 31, in the Massey Funeral Home Chapel with Bro. Melvin Mordecai officiating assisted by Paul Pearson.
