Harry Eaves, age 80, passed away surrounded by his loving family on Monday, January 29, 2018, at North Mississippi Medical Center in Tupelo, Mississippi. Funeral services will be 3 p.m. Wednesday, January 31, in the Nowell Massey Chapel with Rev. Grady Crowell and Rev. Mark Mayo officiating.
