Ivie Dell "Idell" Oglesby, 80, passed away on Wednesday, January 11, 2023, at her home in Louisville, Mississippi. Graveside services and interment will be held at 3 p.m. on Saturday, January 14 in Shiloh Baptist Church Cemetery with Bro. Jay Murphy officiating.

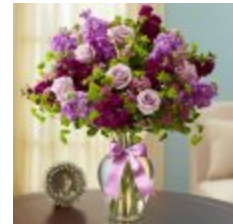
