Jim Cain, 58, was an amazing man: wrestler, t-shirt salesman, radio show host, award winning newspaper columnist, football coach, record producer, furniture salesman, storyteller, Delta Chi fraternity brother, sports photographer, booking agent, bartender, husband, father, and Shepherd of the Lord. Jim was born July 9, 1964, to Jimmie Dan Cain, Sr. and Alice Myrick Cain. He was currently serving as the pastor of Noxapater United Methodist Church in Noxapater, Mississippi.

Jim went to meet his Savior on Thursday, September 29, 2022, at OCH Regional Medical Center in Starkville, Mississippi. 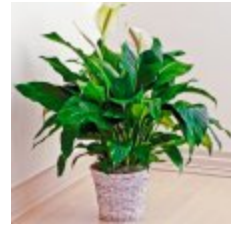
