John Paul Gray, 77, passed away on Tuesday, July 14, 2015, in the Winston Medical Center Hospital in Louisville, Mississippi. 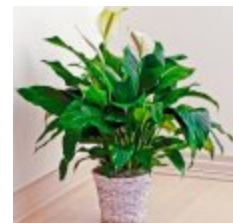
