Jonathan Clark Crocker, 31, passed away on Sunday, October 17, 2021, in Louisville, Mississippi. Funeral services will be 2 p.m. on Wednesday, October 20 at Flower Ridge United Methodist Church with Rev. Keith Williams officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 1 p.m. until service time at the church. Interment will immediately follow the service in Flower Ridge Cemetery.

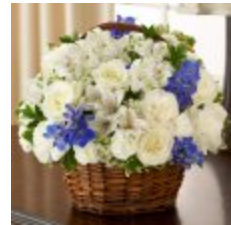
