



## Larry Stone Kennedy

Dr. Larry Stone Kennedy, age 64, passed away at his home in Madison, Mississippi on June 12, 2019.

Larry was born August 26, 1954 to Noble and Evelyn Stone Kennedy of McCool, Mississippi.

He graduated from Louisville High School in 1972. After graduation, he attended Mississippi State University attaining his bachelor's degree and his master's degree in agriculture. He then attended the University of Tennessee, where he received another bachelor's degree and his PhD.

Upon graduation, he went to work for Ferry-Morse Seed Company in San Juan Bautista, California. He enjoyed overseeing vegetable breeder labs in California, France, Chili and other countries.
