Leon Fuller, 95, passed away on Wednesday, October 4, 2023, at his home in Louisville, Mississippi, surrounded by his loving family. Visitation will be from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. on Saturday, October 7 at Nowell-Massey Funeral Home. 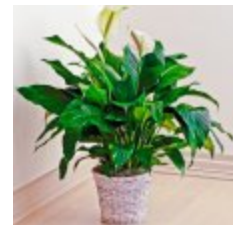
