



## Linn Harry McCubbin

January 18, 1946 - January 29, 2016

Linn Harry “Mack” McCubbin, 70, formerly of Louisville, passed away on Friday, January 29, 2016, at the Memorial Hermann Memorial City Medical Center in Houston, Texas. Graveside services and interment will be at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 3, 2016, at Memorial Park Cemetery in Louisville, Mississippi, with Rev. Marcus “Markie” Jackson and Mark Jackson officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 12 p.m. until 12:45 p.m. at Nowell Massey Funeral Home in Louisville.
