



Louis Delano "Lou" Fioramonti

March 28, 1933 - June 17, 2023

Louis Delano Fioramonti, 90, passed away Saturday, June 17, 2023, at Winston Medical Center in Louisville, Mississippi, with his loving family at his side. Funeral services will be 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, June 20 in the Nowell-Massey Funeral Home Chapel with Dr. Bob Massey officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 10:00 a.m. until service time at Nowell-Massey Funeral Home in Louisville. Interment will immediately follow the service in Good Hope Cemetery.

Lou, a descendant of Italian immigrants, was born to Ciro and Caterina Nuzzi Fioramonti on March 28, 1933, in Washington, D. C. He began his career as a police officer with the Washington, D. C. police department. Later, he transferred to serve in the Secret Service Uniform Division at the White House. He was always so proud to be a first-generation secret service agent that his country entrusted him to protect. Lou answered the call of his country by serving in the United States Navy.
