Robert Moody, Jr., 60, went to meet his Savior on Tuesday, August 19, 2025, at his home in Louisville, Mississippi, with his loving family by his side. Funeral services will be Friday, August 22 at 11 a.m. in the Massey Funeral Home Chapel with Reverend Jason Gross officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service from 9:00 a.m. until service time at the funeral home. Interment will immediately follow the service in Good Hope Cemetery.

Robert was born February 24, 1965, to Robert Moody, Sr. and Ann Crowson Moody in Louisville. He was a member of Good Hope Baptist Church. For 20 years, Robert was a dedicated employee at Wal-Mart, where his friendly smile and warm personality made him a fixture in the store and a friend to all who walked through the doors.
