Ronald James "Ronnie" Hurt, 62, passed away Thursday, October 24, 2024, in Jacksonville, Florida. A memorial service and interment for Ronnie will be 10 a.m. Saturday, November 16 at Sardis Cemetery in Winston County with Reverend Dwayne Kelsey officiating.

Ronnie was born June 24, 1962, to Tom and Josephine Davis Hurt in Shreveport, Louisiana. He was a 1980 graduate of Louisville High School. After 23 years of service, he retired as a Senior Chief from the United States Navy where he was a Gas Turbine Systems Technician (GSE). Ronnie loved to ride his Harley motorcycle. 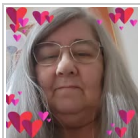

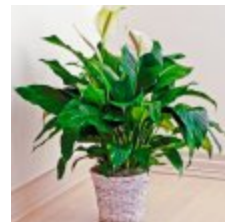
