Terrell Y. "Terry" Wright, Jr., 79, passed away on Saturday, December 21, 2024, at his home in the Nanih Waiya Community with those who dearly loved him by his side. Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Monday, December 23 in the Massey Funeral Home Chapel in Louisville, Mississippi, with Reverend Jerry Lundy officiating.
