



## Toby Wilson

Toby Wilson, 65, passed away suddenly on Saturday, June 14, 2014, at Winston Medical Center in Louisville, Mississippi. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, at Rocky Hill United Methodist Church with Rev. Larry Haggard officiating. Visitation will be on Monday, June 16, 2014, at Nowell-Massey Funeral Home from 4 p.m. until 7 p.m. and at the church on Tuesday from 10 a.m. until service time. 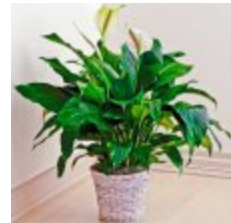
