Ms. Vera Mozell Black Eubanks, 90, passed away surrounded by her loving family on Wednesday, October 25, 2017, at St. Dominic Hospital in Jackson, Mississippi. Funeral services will be Saturday, October 28, 2017, at 2 p.m. in the Nowell Massey Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Roger Griffith officiating.
