



## Wayne Gordon

May 30, 1949 - January 29, 2020

Coyt Wayne Gordon, age 70, passed away surrounded by his loving family and friends Wednesday, January 29, 2020, at the University of Mississippi Medical Center in Jackson, Mississippi. Visitation will be Friday, January 31, from 5:00 p.m. until 7 p.m. at Nowell Massey Funeral Home in Louisville; and one hour prior to the service at the church on Saturday. Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Saturday, February 1, at First Presbyterian Church with Rev. Scott Phillips and Rev. T. J. Jennings officiating. Wayne was born May 30, 1949, to Coyt and Geneva Smith Gordon in Winston County. He is a graduate of Weir High School after which he earned an associate's degree from Holmes Junior College. Wayne was an avid outdoorsman so his next career move was Wildlife Management through the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks. Wayne was a fan of any sports activity at Mississippi State University.

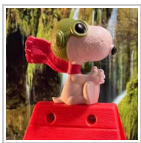

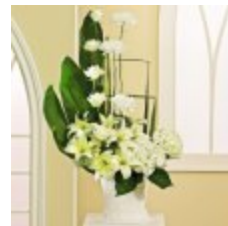
