Wayren Glenn Dickerson, 70, passed away peacefully at his home in Louisville, Mississippi, on Saturday, October 15, 2022, surrounded by his loving family. Visitation will be Monday, October 17 from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. at Nowell-Massey Funeral Home in Louisville. Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Tuesday, October 18 in the Nowell-Massey Funeral Home Chapel. Interment will immediately follow the service in Evergreen Cemetery in Louisville with Bro.
