William Steven "Bill" Sullivan completed his journey on Earth on Saturday, February 29, 2020. He is now resting in the loving arms of Jesus, his Lord and Savior. Funeral services will be 2 p.m. Tuesday, March 3 at South Louisville Baptist Church with Bro. Rob Faulk and Bro. Trent Jaudon officiating. Visitation will be the day of the service at South Louisville Baptist Church from 11:00 a.m. until service time. Interment will immediately follow the service in Memorial Cemetery.

Bill was born to the late John Wesley Sullivan, Sr. and the late Mary Clay Sullivan on February 1, 1967. He was 53 years old at the time of his death. 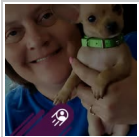

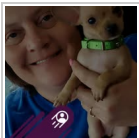

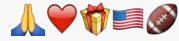
